

### Accreditation and daily infield passes

ID cards will be given out at the hotel at OC upon arrival or will be produced in the oval.

We kindly ask you to bring a copy of your passport or other official identification document. <u>Access to the ice training will be open only for accredited Team members starting Monday,08. December.</u>

We kindly ask you to return the plastic accreditation cases, lanyards and infield passes to the OC office in the hotel at check out or to the accreditation desk in the oval.

Infield passes will be distributed each day at the Accreditation desk in the oval during B group races. Infield passes restrict access to the infield for both Athletes and Team Officials beginning from the start of the first distance of A group until the end of the last ceremony of the competition day.














## **Friends and Family Tickets**

Skaters can request two tickets per day of their competition for family members and friends. Each Team Leader has to pre-order the tickets via the <u>Ticket Request Form</u> before Tuesday, December 9, 20:00. The tickets can be picked up by a Team Leader from the OC Desk in Scandic Hotel on Thursday.

### **Warming up Facilities**

The skaters can warm up in the gym located on the ground floor and infield. Bikes can be placed in the curve outside of the paddings only. Please do not put massage tables in that zone.

Times for ice training sessions is according to the Training Schedule posted in the ISU Events App.

### **Training Facilities at Scandic Hotel**

Scandic Hamar has a room "Hamarhallen" available from Monday until Sunday for the bikes. Please do not leave bikes and bike cases in the corridors.

There is a small gym in the hotel, opening hours 06:00-23:00.

#### Oval

### **Team Leaders Meeting**

The Team Leaders Meeting is organized as a physical meeting on Thursday, December 11 at 16:00 in Scandic Hotel, room "Storhamar 2".

### Welcome reception

All Team Leaders and coaches are invited for a welcome reception held in the Official hotel outside of the meeting room "Storhamar 2" on Thursday, December 11 at 15:30. There will be some welcome speeches, drinks and snacks.

#### **Draw and Start lists**

Draw meeting will be closed and the start lists will be published online in the ISU Event App.

### Arrival and departure

Transportation from Oslo Airport Gardermoen will be done by <u>public train service</u> https://www.vy.no/en The train departs from Oslo Airport Gardermoen every hour from 06:59 in the morning until 23:59 in the evening. It is possible to buy train tickets in the ticket machines in the airport, online on at <a href="https://www.vy.no/en">https://www.vy.no/en</a> or from the ticket office in the airport.

The train leaves from track number 1 and it takes 50 minutes from Gardermoen airport to Hamar Railway station. When returning from Hamar to Gardermoen airport, the train leaves every hour from 05:00 until 22:00 (05:00, 06:00, 07:00 etc).

Transportation from Hamar train station to the Official hotel can be Organizing Committee paid by the Teams. Price for both ways: 10 Euro per person. Please ensure you have entered the correct arrival and departure information into the Online Entry System.

## Transportation to the oval

Shuttle bus service will be available between the official hotel and the ice-rink from Monday, December 8 to Sunday, December 14 according to the schedule posted in the ISU Event App.

We recommend walking to the oval and back instead of taking a shuttle. The one-way walk takes about 20 minutes from both hotels.

### Ceremonies

We ask all skaters to be present for the ceremonies immediately upon announcement. Team Leaders are responsible for ensuring that the winners are ready for the ceremonies. The top three skaters of each distance in the A group will be awarded in the infield. The top three skaters of each distance in the B group will be awarded in the mixed zone.














## Designated areas for skaters and team officials

Skaters and team officials have their own marked area on the stands (section G, rows 1-5 at 500m start). The team filming area is in the curve behind the 500m finish line. One camera per Team is allowed. Teams can place their bikes in the curve behind the 500m start as it is marked on the picture.

Team lounge is located on the 1st floor, room "Kinnarps". All Skaters must use designated changing rooms.



#### **Armbands**

All participants must have their own armbands for races.
