Oslo Skøiteklub is growing, and we are looking for an experienced figure skating coach that can contribute to our further success together with our coaching team. The position may be temporary or permanent, to be further decided in dialogue with the relevant candidate.

Oslo Skøiteklub is in the heart of Oslo, currently accessing top facilities for our skaters in Sonja Henie Ishall and at Frogner Stadion. As the only skating club in Norway, we also offer trainings at high level within short track and speed skating. Our figure skating division is the largest one, consisting of approximately 230 skaters, whereof approx. 35 skaters are actively competing. The club is well organized and with a good economy, and also has an operational responsibility for all the winter activities taking place at Sonja Henie Ishall and Frogner stadion. The relevant candidate is a competent professional well experienced within figure skating, enjoying working with the athletes independently of their ambition levels. The position will in its core consist of on-and-off ice trainings, travelling to competitions mainly within Norway, and choreo and prepps for competitions. In addition, the position may also include work to further develop strategies, and ongoing close collaboration with the manager of the club and members of the Board. The work will mainly be performed during afternoons, evenings and during weekends, to be further agreed upon. We might offer adjacent administrative tasks within the club, in addition to the core responsibilities, and we might assist in finding rental appartement in Oslo.
