


HOW TO CONTACT OFFICIALS FOR FEEDBACK- GUIDANCE FOR COACHES



At the request of the coach, the referee or the technical controller can give the feedback at the earliest <u>when the competition is over.</u>


When the competition is over:

- check who you want to contact based on the feedback you would like to receive:
 - you can contact the Technical Controller asking for feedback about levels of difficulties in spins and steps.
 - you can contact the Referee asking for feedback about GOE and PCS.
- check who was the referee and/or the technical controller under the competition in question (you can find this information in the tab *officials* at the competition's schedule)
- decide if you want to contact them directly or via email
- If directly:
 - o make sure officials are not busy before you approach them













- ask for feedback about specific element by mentioning skater, category and segment (short or free)
- If via email:
 - o check the email address in the <u>following document</u>
 - send an email specifying the skater, category, the segment (short of free) and the element in question
 - o be sure to provide ethical language and the right tone of expression

Before the competition:

- Officials may not give feedback to the athlete the same week that the skater is to attend the event.
- Officials should not give feedback to any skater 3 weeks before the competition, if they are to judge them
- Officials can be contacted by the coaches until 3 weeks before the competition, if they have any question/doubt about any element
