- Address constitutional legal requirements under Swiss law and ensure text of each Article is consistent with its intended purpose

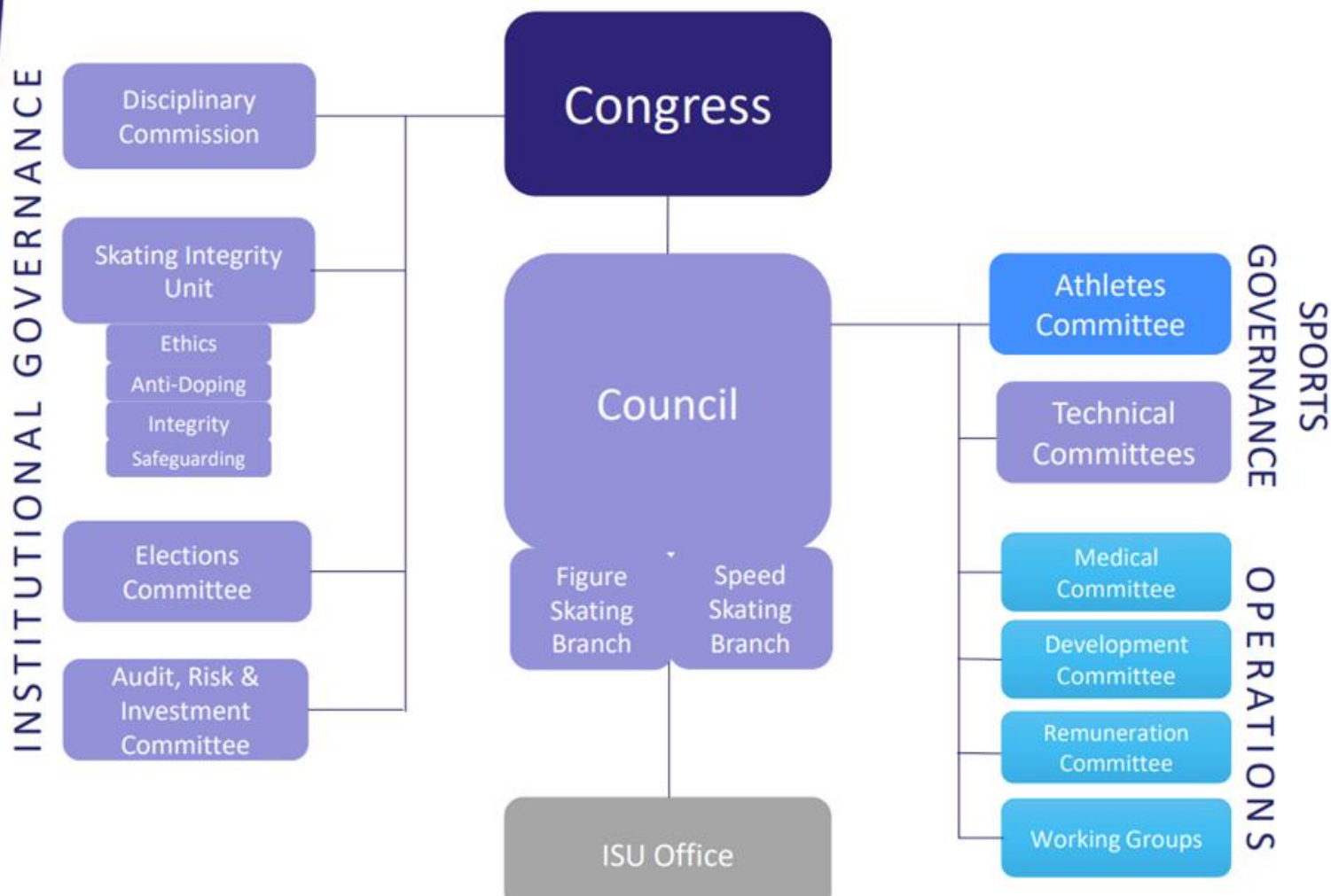
### Consistency

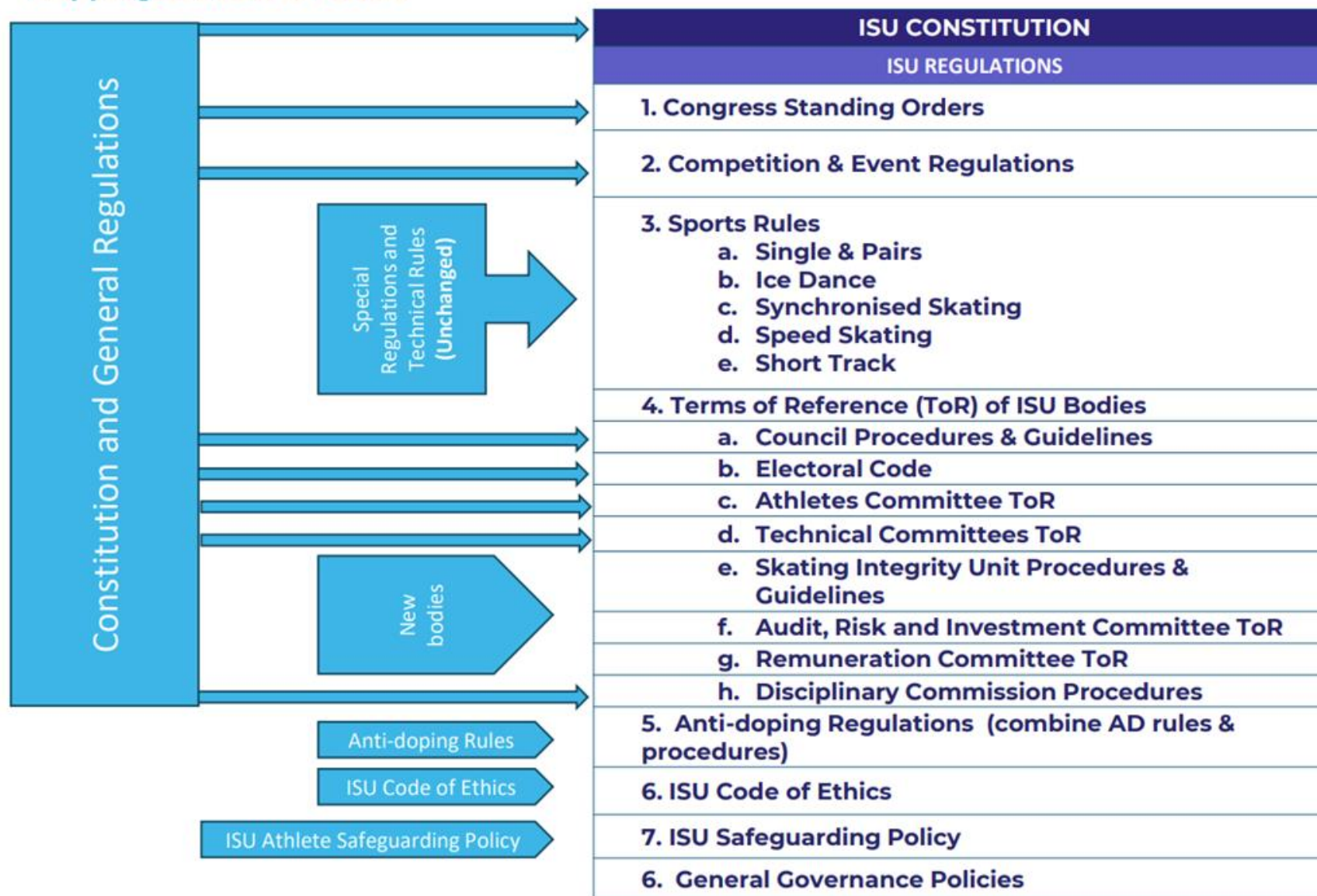
